Preparing for a role in religious leadership? Qualifying candidates must be residents of Iowa with at least three years of post-secondary education and satisfactory scholastic standing to apply for financial awards from the Order of the Eastern Star.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants must be residents of Iowa. Schools must be accredited by The Association of Theological Schools: www.ata.edu.

The selected course of study in the chosen field of religious service must be accredited.

Eligible applicants download application packets, complete and submit them no later than the June 30th deadline.

An official transcript of college credits is required, along with letters of recommendation, one of which must be from an Eastern Star member or a member of the Masonic Lodge.
