Day #3 Monday, June 1, 2026

San Antonio, here we come. Late morning finds us entering San Antonio. Enjoy an early lunch along the Paseo Del Rio before we attend a presentation of "The Price of Freedom", the story of the Alamo at the Imax Theater. We then walk the short distance to Alamo Plaza for a visit to the Mission San Antonio de Valero (the Alamo). We then check into our river walk hotel. The remainder of the afternoon is free.

Built in 1881, it offers a step back into Texas history. (**B,L,Kickback Reception**)

Day #6 Thursday, June 4, 2026

Regretfully, we must depart San Antonio and head north across the rolling hills of south Texas to the prairies of Oklahoma. We retrace our steps to Oklahoma City for our overnight stay. This evening, we take a ride on the Oklahoma City River Walk. Our cruise will pass the Land Rush Memorial. The memorial commemorates the opening of "Unassigned lands in the Oklahoma Territory" in 1889. The monument consists of 47 cast bronze statues of men, women, children, horses and wagons, all 1½ times life size. The evening is free to enjoy Brick town on your own. You might want to try "Mickey Mantle's Steak House". (B)

Day #7 Friday, June 5, 2026

This morning, we will visit the Oklahoma City Memorial and museum to see what really happened April 18th 1995. We depart Oklahoma City and head north and east as we make our way across the remainder of Oklahoma and on into Missouri. Our destination is Joplin. Before checking into our hotel, picture stop will be made at the Grand Falls and the Route 66 Mural Park. This evening, a farewell dinner has been planned at one of Joplin's fine restaurants. Homeward bound. As we make our way back to Iowa and home, a stop will be made at the "Precious Moments Chapel" and gardens. We then continue north through the rest of Missouri, and on in to Iowa. We arrive in Altoona in the mid afternoon with many fond memories of having "Gone to Texas". (B)
